Notes: The AuthentiCare iOS app was tested using several configurations to ensure that the representative sample of screens tested for this report gives sufficient coverage of the app's accessibility features as a whole. This report includes evaluation of features of the app that support the entry of non-EVV time at check-out (but does not cover evaluation of the "Client Attestation" feature).

Evaluation Methods Used: Manual testing using Level Access's AMP platform and use case testing with the iOS VoiceOver screen reader.
