Product Description: iOS app for workers that forms part of the AuthentiCare Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) solution. The iOS app is used with a website and backend, which is typically customized for state healthcare entities.

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Notes: The AuthentiCare iOS app was tested using several configurations to ensure that the representative sample of screens tested for this report gives sufficient coverage of the app's accessibility features as a whole.

Evaluation Methods Used: Manual testing using Level Access's AMP platform and use case testing with the iOS VoiceOver screen reader.
